### Objective of this Workshop

The focus of this workshop is for laying a Christian foundation for ministers to work with Jesus in bringing inner healing to survivors of severe trauma, trafficking, and ritual abuse.

Introduction to Dissociative Identity Disorder and severe trauma ministry.

Definiton – what is D.I.D.

Mental – what do survivors silently endure?

Physical - what do survivors go through daily?

Spiritual aspects – is this demonic?

*Is there a small booklet out there that will help my friends and family understand what I am going through? I feel so alone. No one understands what I am truly going through on a day to day basis. No one knows how to pray for me. - client*

- I. Trauma is an emotional response to a terrible event.
  - A. Trauma occurs when our emotional capacity is overwhelmed.
    1. Traumatized - a single experience
    2. Traumatization = a series of experiences
    3. Severely traumatized = prolonged severe experiences (torture, abduction, abuse, rape, pain).
  - B. Trauma and Suffering
    1. Trauma is anything that reduces who we are and who we understand ourselves to be.
    2. Suffering – when the emotional capacities are drastically reduced, and the individual continues on with what emotion is left.
  - C. Two Types of Trauma
    1. Type A – the absence of good things in life.
    2. Type B – the presence of bad things in life.
  - D. Severe Trauma Examples
    1. Physical, and verbal abuse.
    2. Sexual abuse
    3. Ritual abuse
- II. Dissociation is God's gift to surviving severe trauma
  - A. Dissociation is how the brain disconnects

1. Dissociation occurs in the mind (the soul), not chemical or mental illness.
  2. God's design to help a child cope with extremely overwhelming trauma.
  3. No external way of escape the child escapes inside of themselves.
  4. Mental walls, realities created, where physical escape was impossible.
- B. Repetitive and Prolonged Dissociation
1. Identities – part of the soul created by dissociation during trauma.
- III. D.I.D. Programming – enslaving the child's soul
- A. Childhood trafficking and abduction
1. Child pornography survivors
  2. Abductee survivors (predator and the occult)
  3. Ritual abuse survivors (cults and the occult)
- B. Programming – enslaving a human soul
1. Human soul and identity parts are enslaved through traumatic conditioning (torture).
  2. Program – instructions deliberately placed in an identity for control over the individual.
  3. Used by captor for conditioning “parts” for child pornography, prostitution, and ritual abuse.
  4. Programs reinforced by torture and by perpetrating parts.
- C. Ritual Abuse
1. Deliberate use of dissociation to gain control and behavior of child through prolonged exposure to trauma, pain, sexual abuse, fear, and terror.
- IV. D.ID. Prayer Ministry for inner healing.
1. Jesus heals the fractured soul.
  2. Romans 12:2 – Healing from D.I.D. comes through a renewed mind.
  3. Doctrinal ministries of sozo and deliverance are to be avoided with D.I.D.
  4. D.I.D. prayer ministry requires focused prayer on establishing truths and breaking free from the occult (not deliverance).
